

### **Synopsis**

Why do dentists have the highest suicide rate among health care professionals in India?

In 32 White, we travel to Davanagere, a small town in Karnataka, India, known for one of the best dental colleges in India, and investigate the cavities in the system. The film traces the lives of over 15 dental students, in their last year at the institute and skirts the perimeter of their changed lives by visiting the unseen and unknown segments of pressure, stress, and unethical practices they indulge in, just to become dentists. 32 White is segmented into chapters which we call cavities, each dwelling over issues like caste, creed, ragging, family pressure, professor harassment, peer pressure, dental syllabus, and many more leading into the last chapter: Dental Suicides.

Mriidu Khosla, Founder/Director at Zcyphher (An independent creative agency), is a documentary filmmaker with two award-winning documentaries under her belt as an Assistant Director, *Inshallah Football* (National Award Winner) and *Inshallah Kashmir*.
